Sexual Violence 2013 Annual Report for Campbell County Adult Detention Center

Data included in this report is from January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013

Inmates confined in CCADC on December 31, 2013 were 114 males and 0 females.

During 2013, new admissions to the jail were 886 males and 125 females.

The average daily population at CCADC in 2013 was 93 males and 0 females.

Inmate on Inmate Sexual Violence

The categories of inmate on inmate sexual violence are reported separately and are:

Non-consensual acts:

- Contact of any person without his or her consent, or of a person who is unable to consent or refuse; and
- Contact between the penis and the vagina or the penis and the anus including penetration; or
- Contact between the mouth and the penis, vagina, or anus; or
- Penetration of the anal or genital opening of another person by hand, finger, or other object.

Abusive Sexual Contacts:

- Contact of any person without consent, or of a person who is unable to consent or refuse; and
- Intentional touching, either directly or through the clothing, of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or buttocks of any person, excluding contact incidental to a physical altercation.

The Blue Ridge Regional Jail Authority records all allegations of inmate on inmate sexual violence. There were zero allegations of inmate on inmate non-consensual acts during this period. There were zero allegations of inmate on inmate abusive sexual contact during this period.

Staff Sexual Misconduct and Harassment

Staff sexual misconduct and harassment includes any behavior or act of a sexual nature directed toward an inmate by an employee, volunteer, contractor, official visitor, or other agency representative, and includes two categories which are reported separately and defined as follows:

Staff Sexual Misconduct / consensual or non-consensual acts including:

- Intentional touching of the genitalia, anus, groin, breast, inner thigh, or buttocks with the intent to arouse, or gratify sexual desire; or
- Completed, attempted, threatened, or requested sexual acts; or
- Occurrences of indecent exposure, invasion of privacy, or staff voyeurism for sexual gratification.

Staff Sexual Harassment includes:

- Repeated verbal statements or comments of a sexual nature to an inmate by an employee, volunteer, contractor, official visitor, or other agency representative;
- Demeaning references to gender or derogatory comments about body or clothing; or
- Repeated profane or obscene language or gestures.

The Blue Ridge Regional Jail Authority records all allegations of staff sexual misconduct and sexual harassment. There were zero allegations of staff sexual misconduct on inmates during this period. There were zero allegations of staff sexual harassment on inmates during this period.

From January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013, the Campbell County Adult Detention Center had zero reports of inmate on inmate sexual violence (non-consensual acts and/or abusive sexual acts). There were zero reports of staff sexual misconduct (consensual or non-consensual acts) and/or sexual harassment reported at the Campbell County Adult Detention Center.

For the years of 2010 through 2012, there were zero reported incidents of inmate on inmate non-consensual or abusive sexual contacts. During the same time frame there were zero reported incidents of staff sexual misconduct or sexual harassment. The PREA review committee convened to discuss our current procedures, and if they are sufficient in addressing the issue of sexual abuse in our facility. The Campbell County Adult Detention Center has not taken corrective actions due to having no incidence of sexual abuse or sexual harassment. The Campbell County Adult Detention Center has taken a proactive approach on the issues of inmate sexual abuse and sexual harassment. The facility continues to conduct annual PREA training and PREA roll call training throughout the year.
